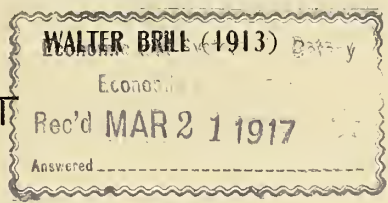

To Gardeners, Truckers and Plant Growers:

Our Business of Seed Growing was first established by John Brill, father of the late Francis Brill, at Jersey City, N. J., in 1828.

Francis Brill, after serving several years with his father, started on his own account at Newark, N. J., in 1859—removed to Long Island in 1870, where he made a specialty of growing cabbage seed, and supplying a few other specialties grown by the most reliable growers. until his death, March 24th, 1913.

The undersigned son of Francis Brill, was raised on a seed farm, graduated from the New Hampshire Agricultural College (1885), served nine years with two of the largest seed houses in the country and is fully qualified to carry on the business.

Our Cabbage Seed stocks are as pure as it is possible to make them. Each variety is grown far apart on separate farms, to prevent mixing by the winds and by bees which carry the pollen from flower to flower when planted in close proximity to each other. The fields are carefully "rogued" (inferior heads discarded) and a supply of the very finest heads set apart from the main crop for the next years stock seed.

Other seeds which we offer are grown for us by special growers selected by the late Francis Brill after careful tests of their stocks, and all orders receive the same careful attention exercised by him for 54 years.
