CERTIFICATE OF NURSERY INSPECTION No. 11

SEASON 1916-1917

This is to Certify, That in accordance with an Act of the Legislature, approved April 17, 1905, the nursery grounds of Marble City Nurseries at Knoxville, County of Knox, State of Tennessee, were in spected by G. M. Bentley, J. E. Blake, H. B. Drane, on July 28-29, 1916. The growing nursery stock was apparently free from San Jose Scale and other dangerously injurious insect pests and plant diseases.

Said nurseries, unless such stock is covered by proper Certificate in favor of the nursery where grown. It is not transferable and may be revoked for cause.

This Certificate becomes invalid after August 1st, 1917, and cannot be legally used after that date.

Budded on Imported French stock, branch rooted No. 1, 7 to 12 m. m. Our Pear Trees have made extra fine growth. We have 75 thousand in one block that will go from 4 to 7 feet high, a good proportion of them are nicely branched. In June, when they were $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet high, we pinched off the terminal ends and made them branch. They look like two year trees. Can furnish straight whips or branched trees as wanted. Our Keifer and Garber are nearly all heavily branched.
