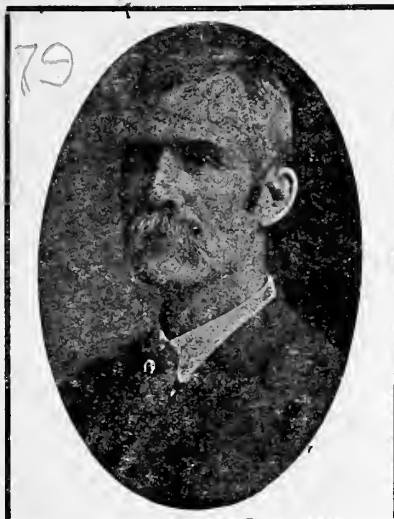

If you send a \$25.00 order, you may select \$1.25 worth of stock and add it to your order. Or, we will send you one nice Apple Tree (our selection) for every \$5.00 worth of nursery stock you buy before March 15, 1917. We can only allow you one offer with each order.
