We will make Whole Root Grafts in any style wanted, but for our regular Whole Root Grafts we use  $\frac{3}{8}$ -inch and up Seedlings, grafting at the collar. The roots are cut back to eight inches.

Terms on Grafts are one-fourth of amount with the order, and balance when ordered shipped.
