For the convenience of customers, I have arranged an alphabetical list of the cannas tested out by me with my estimated stock for sale for coming season, height, color leaf, color flower and duplicates and near duplicates.

I have tested out many more cannas than are here and have only kept in this list, those which are still used by some dealers. It is only fair to say that when testing out a new canna, if I found it equal in every point to an old one and superior in even one point, I discarded the old one and when sufficient stock of new was grown, used that for both. But if the old canna had even one point of superiority, I retained it.

Of course, I may have gotten in some instances, poor strains of a variety but I have gotten my trial lots, where ever possible from the producers on a new variety and where they did not come up to descriptions, I have gotten sample lots of same cannas elsewhere. In one case, I have gotten one much vaunted canna from five different parties so as to be sure.

I have also studied cannas in parks, exhibitions and grower's grounds and am continually revising and improving not only descriptions but also my strains by continuous roguing in this wonderful climate where cannas are in bloom almost every month of the year.

## NEW AND NOTABLE CANNAS

Here I only describe new cannas and connect them with older ones and I have tried to formulate a standard

### SUGGESTIONS ARE WELCOME

**REDS**—Prince Wied and Uncle Sam are a little better in substance, cleanliness and lasting quality than the very good old red Louisiana, etc., but tho the flowers hold up better.

American Beauty and Wm. Boffinger are new reds of a lighter and more orange tone than the two last and of same fine substance.

Wintzer's Colossal is the largest flower on any canna I have but the petals lack substance and flop so that it is really not much more than a curiosity. It is not as showy as the older cannas.

Dr. Robt. Funke is one of the best red cannas that grow 3—4 ft high, with small flower.

Julius Koch has better shaped petals and larger flowers than any.

Meteor I have developed to equal Julius Koch, altho not quite as dark.

New York is a very satisfactory bronze leaf growing sturdy and strong with a large deep red flower. It grows taller than Wm. Saunders and that class and is a better flower.

Rubin has a smaller flower but more blossoms at one time, making a fine display; and the color is rich and strong. It is an addition for bedding.

**ORANGE**—San Benito is a new orange with green leaf, growing 3—4 feet high. It is a strong grower, has a truss flower of a lovely, strong orange changing as it grows older to a pink. The flower is large with fine rounded petals. It is entirely different from the orchid flowered Indiana canna. It makes a fine bedding display.

**YELLOW**—Many new yellows have been put out recently and among the best are Richard Wallace and Wm. Bates, both have large flowers with the high-bred rounded petals and both have pink spots in throat adding to a near-by view; but at a distance the effect is yellow. The latter is a clear, lemon yellow while the former is paler and more delicate.

Chas. Lutz, Goldbird and Queen Queen of Yellows are nearly identical and in these, the flowers are larger, the petals wider and more rounded and the whole effect more lovely. They show the effect of finer breeding.

**WHITES**—The first-class white canna has not yet arrived. Moonlight is a strong grower and prolific flowerer but its flower is small and nearly always a true white. Blanche Wintzer has so weak a constitution that only continued petting can keep it alive. Eureka and Maros are stronger but not pure white; they are cream and often have pink spots in throat. The flowers are very lovely and I retain the cannas as worth while but they bring a high price.

**PINKS**—Hungaria and Mrs. A. F. Conard are the loveliest cannas grown. The first is a strong blue pink and the latter a soft lighter, yellow pink. Both have wide, rounded petals, large flowers and good lasting qualities and are strong growers. I would rank La Donna as very close to them; it is still lighter in color.

**PINK and GOLD**—Alba Rosen has never had the sale that its lovely peachblow color and strangely formed flower calls for. It does not look like a canna.

Venus for beauty of coloring and substance and lasting quality of flower belongs in same class as Hungaria, etc. Czuczor and Rossini are wonderfully lovely cannas with big, soft creamed pink flowers.

**SCARLET and GOLD**—Ducca Di Otranto and Madame Sieberf are two new cannas that are identical. Height 3 to 3½ feet, green foliage, strong growers and prolific bloomers. Truss flowers fairly full, flower medium size 4 inches across, petals 1¼ to 1½ across. Color a rich, Indian or golden yellow, changing without spots or lines, into a dark, rich carmine at center, very striking and original. It is a wonderfully striking canna.

Claude Montel is striking with its blood red and gold; and Terisa for a dwarf canna for edgings, gives a wonderfully gay effect.

**ORANGE and GOLD**—Stuttgartia: This is a wonderfully fine canna, very like Flambeau and F. Benary, which I have had for years, and so class these all together.

Panama: This is a wonderfully fine canna, altho its dead blossoms stick to its flower spikes too long. Its petals are big and rounded and the shape of the flower is of the finest and its coloring, a strong terra-cotta orange-red with bordering and spots of gold, is very unique. Green leaves, 3—4 feet high.
