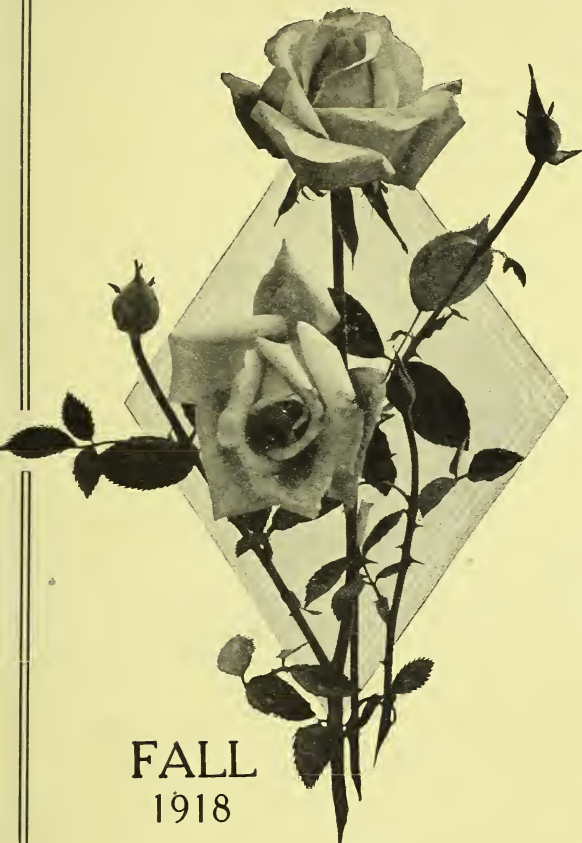

This List Cancels All Previous Quotations

Our freight and express office is at Roseacres, Coahoma County, Mississippi; sixty-two miles south of Memphis, Tennessee, on the Y. & M. V. R. R. Our telegraph office is at Clarksdale, Miss. All messages are transmitted to us by phone.

CREDIT: We will not accept orders until we believe the buyer is responsible for the account. Cash before shipment from buyers unknown to us, or references with sufficient time for investigation before shipment. All bills are due net in sixty days, unless other arrangements are made at time of sale.

SHIPMENTS: The risk and cost of transportation belong to the purchaser. Where instructions are not given as to route or conveyance, we ship as we think serves our mutual interests without assuming responsibility.

PRICES: We quote prices per 10, per 100, and per 1,000, as our stock warrants, and will supply the trade at prices named regardless of the size of the order, except in cases of long, selected lists of small quantities, when an additional charge will be made to cover cost of the extra labor involved. Prices are subject to market changes.

GRADES AND BUNCHING: We grade our plants to a uniform weight. We are particular as to caliper and height. All stock is graded under cover, and every effort is made to keep plants in proper condition until boxed for shipment. Roses and shrubs are tied in bunches of 10 and 25 plants to the bunch. Please make your orders in multiples of these quantities.
