CLAIMS, for any cause, must be made promptly on receipt of goods.

NOTICE. We have always made it prominent in our printed terms that our goods are sold F.O.B. the cars at point of shipment and are at the purchaser's risk while in transit. Because of the present unsettled conditions we wish to emphasize still further that we do not guarantee safe delivery. The ownership of all goods sold by us passes to the purchaser on delivery by us to the carrier and the issuing of a receipt by the carrier ends our responsibility. And claims for damage should be made promptly to the agent at the point of delivery.
