Measurement made from top of roots to top of tree.

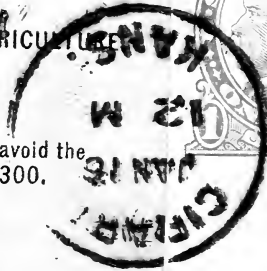
