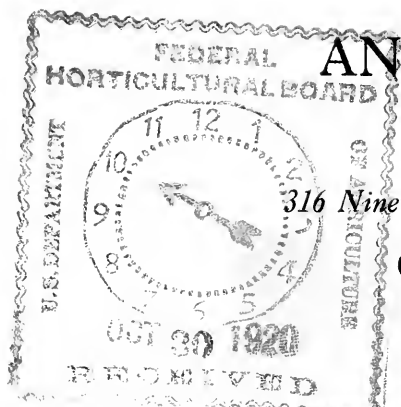

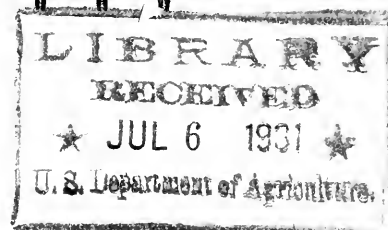

Lilac, Our own grafted two year old, field grown, with fibrous roots, well branched, especially adapted for pot plant growing and forcing, in about ten varieties:- First size, \$50 per 100, Second size, \$40 per 100, Third size, \$35 per 100.
