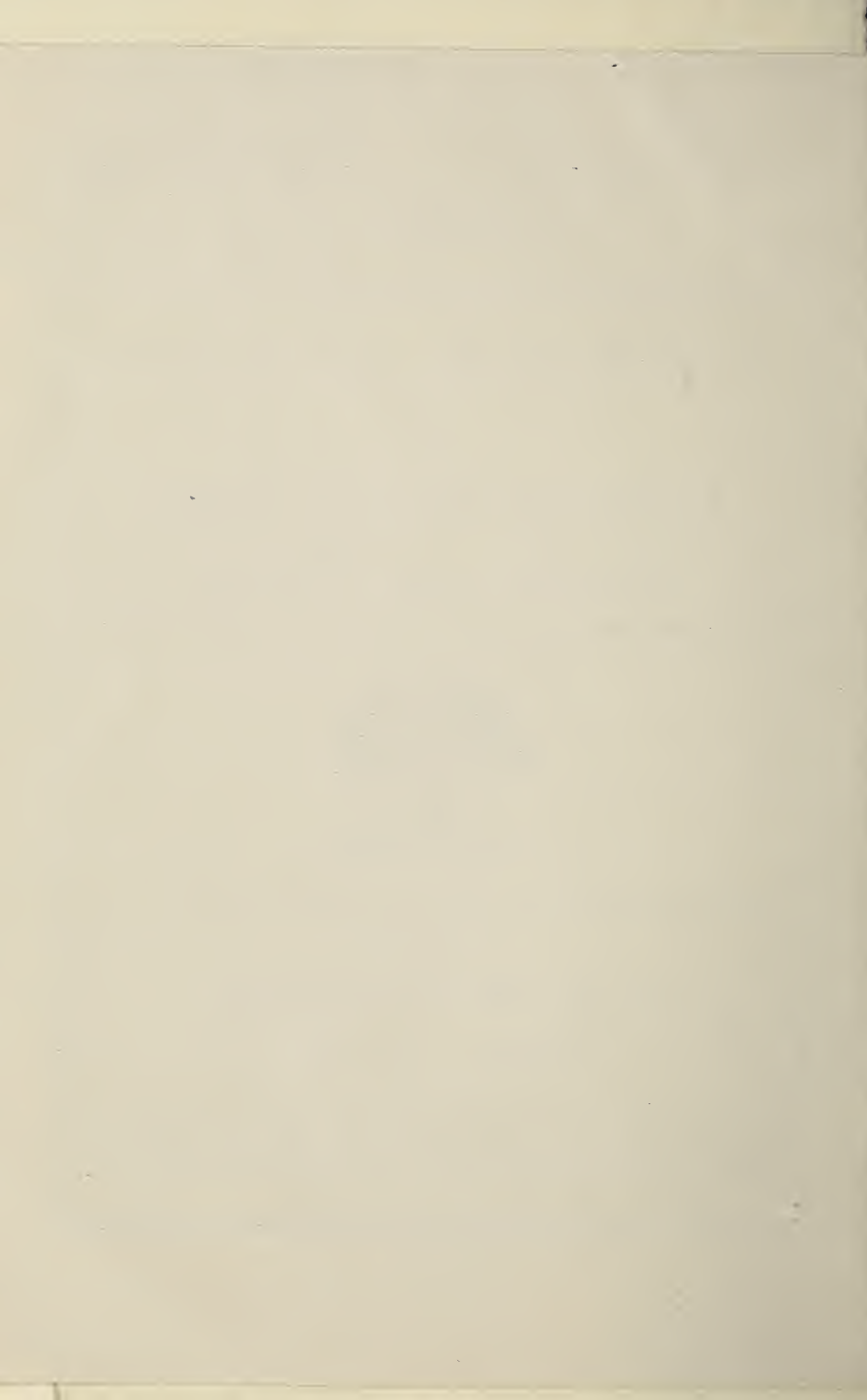

LOCATION.

Exeter is located 50 miles northeast of Boston on the Boston and Maine railroad in direct communication with Boston and New York.

Our shipping season begins about the middle of April and lasts until June 1st and from September until the middle of November.

Not less than 50 and 500, unless otherwise arranged for, will be furnished at 100 and 1000 rates respectively.

As I have no control over the transportation, planting, and weather I can assume no responsibility after delivering the stock for transportation.

REMARKS.
