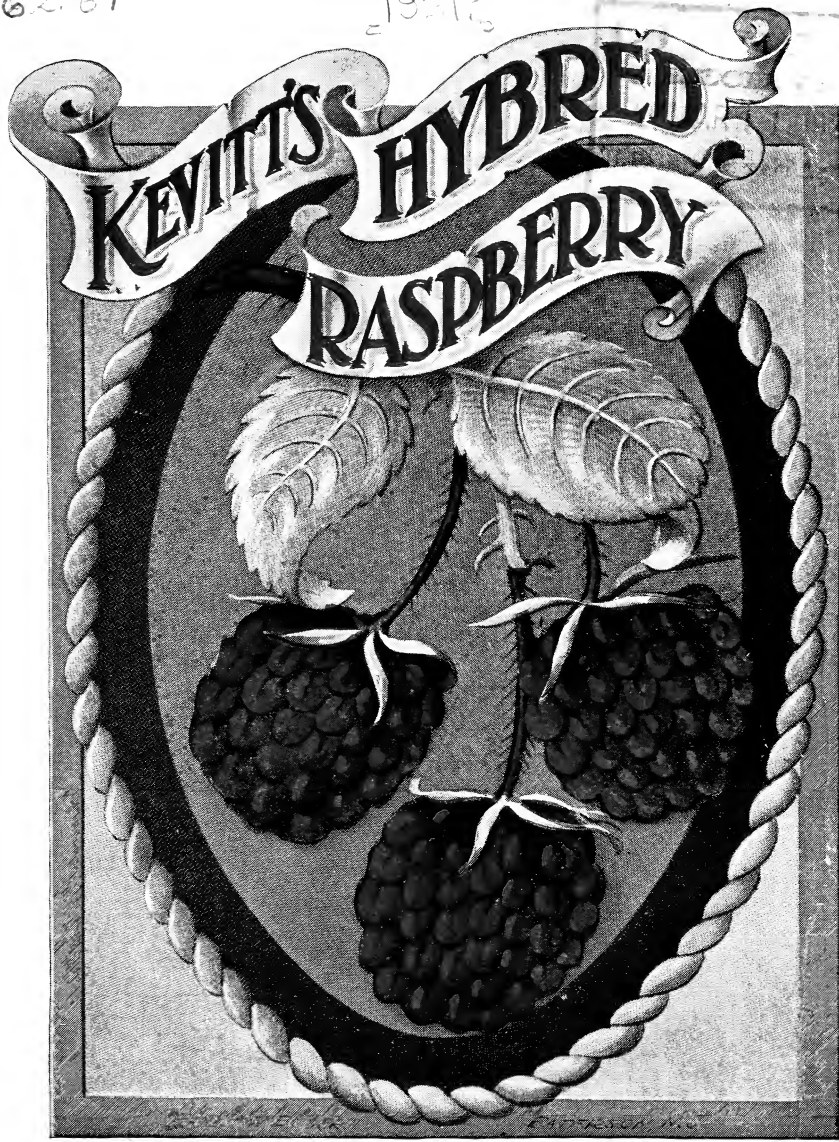

The canes attain a height of from six to ten feet and are alive in the spring, not winter killing during the many hard winters we have had during the past years.

The foliage is perfect, resisting fungus and insect attacks in a marked degree.

The fruit is large to very large and continues so throughout the whole picking season.

The color is bright crimson and does not fade after picking as is the fault of many former varieties.

The time of ripening in this locality is about the middle of June and its season of picking is from four to five weeks, thus a good advantage of the market may be taken.
