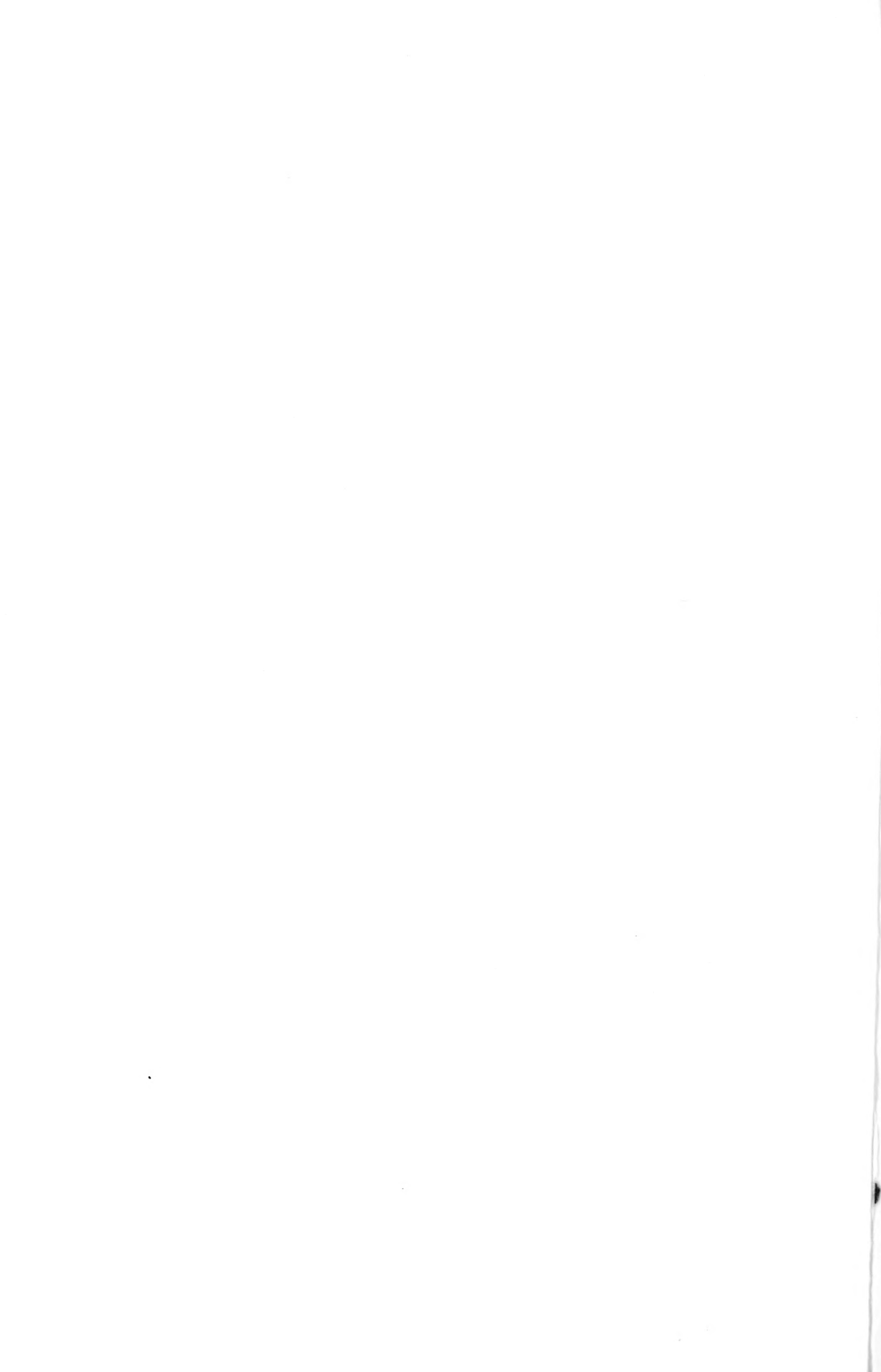

THE NURSERIES

THE Aurora Nurseries are located 37 miles west of Chicago on the main line of the Chicago, Burlington & Quincy, the Chicago & Northwestern, the Chicago, Milwaukee & Gary, and the Chicago Outer Belt Line. We have almost direct service by all Express lines. The shipping facilities from Aurora are not to be excelled. Our establishment began in 1903 and has steadily grown until today finds us doing business in almost every state. Our equipment is up-to-date and all orders are handled with promptness.

We are deeply grateful to our friends for their past patronage and solicit a continuation of mutual cordial relations. Visitors to our Nurseries are always welcome.

We give particular attention to the propagation and growth of Ornamental Shrubs, although we grow a considerable quantity of shade and ornamental trees.

TERMS, ETC.

HOW TO SHIP—When ordering always specify whether we shall ship by freight or express. Also give us the route if possible. When no directions are given we will use our best judgment as to how to ship, but in no case will we be responsible after goods are consigned to purchaser. When losses or damage occur while goods are in transit, either from delay or otherwise, make claim at once to forwarding Companies.

TERMS—Terms of payment are cash or security before shipment. The usual terms of credit will be accorded to established firms, who if not known to us will please forward references. C. O. D. orders must be accompanied by one-fourth the amount of the order in cash.

PRICES—Prices are for the Spring 1922. This list supersedes all other lists and is subject to change without notice. Five plants of a variety will be supplied at the rate per ten—fifty at the rate per hundred—five hundred at the rate per thousand.

PACKING—Prices in this List are Net; cost of Boxes, Bales, etc., will be added.

GUARANTY—While we exercise the greatest care to have our trees and plants true to label, and hold ourselves prepared to replace, on proper proof, all that may prove untrue, we do not give any warranty expressed or implied, and in case of any error on our part, it is mutually agreed between the purchaser and ourselves that we shall not at any time be held responsible for a greater amount than the original price of the stock.

TO OUR CUSTOMERS—On all orders placed with us, stock is sold at the nurseries without freight allowance. The plants become your property upon delivery of them to the Transportation Company, and we cannot be responsible for loss, damage or delay in transit. Your recourse is with the Transportation Company, and not with us. If plants arrive in bad condition, before receipting for them, require the Station Agent to note same on the freight or express receipt, then make your claim on the Transportation Company. If you accept shipments short of what is enumerated on our invoice, or in bad condition without proper notation on freight or express receipt, the loss will be yours. Every assistance in our power will be cheerfully rendered you to trace and recover lost goods and collect damages.
