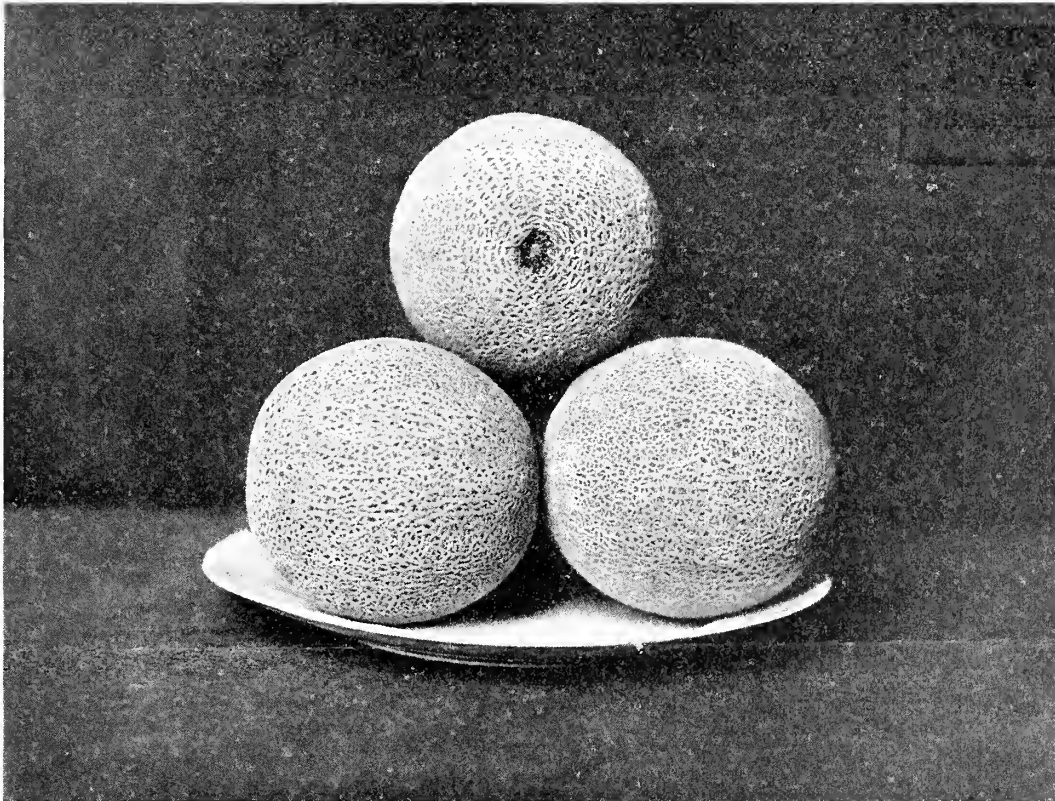

In case of shortage or failure of crops, deliveries will be made prorata with no responsibility on the part of ourselves for such failures or shortages.

In addition to our regular Price List, we make a specialty of growing from choice and valuable stocks furnished by our customers and give them special supervision.

Special price on 500 lbs. or more of any one variety.

Deliveries made F. O. B. cars, Valley, Nebraska.

Bags charged at wholesale cost price.

These stocks are offered under the non-warranty clause adopted by the American Seed Trade Association, viz:

We, the C. Herbert Coy Seed Co., give no warranty, express or implied, as to the description, quality, productiveness or any other matter of any seeds or seed corn we send out; and we will not be in any way responsible for the crop. If the purchaser does not accept the goods under these terms, they are at once to be returned.

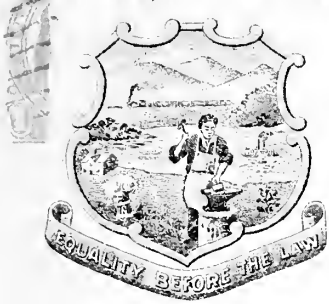
**TERMS:**—Sweet Corn and Vine Seeds, net 60 days from date of invoice. Usual cash discount allowed 10 days.

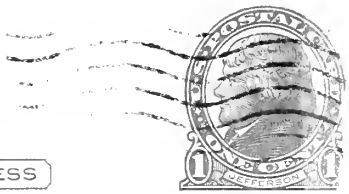
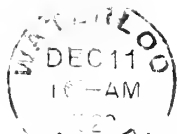

## **SWEET CORN, FIELD CORN AND VINE SEEDS**

As soon as some of our contract crops are in hand, cleaned and tested, we expect to have Stowell's Evergreen, Golden Bantam and DeLue's Golden Giant Sweet Corn to offer. We can probably quote by mail with samples in about one week.

In Field Corn we expect to have the usual list of standard kinds to offer. Identical samples will not be available until deliveries to us begin, but if informed of your requirements in kinds, quantities and time of shipment, will do our best to serve you.

In Vine Seeds we have Squash Early White Bush Scallop, Mammoth White Bush Scallop, Early Yellow Bush Scallop and Bush Summer Crookneck for immediate shipment. Also Kleckley's, Sweetheart, Dixie and Cuban Queen Watermelons. No surplus of Muskmelon or Cucumber except perhaps a few pounds each of Acme, Shumway's Giant and Honey Dew, and of Extra Long White Spine and Early Frame.
