All objects having more than one common name, such as Mule or Donkey, house or home, etc., will be counted as one object, either synonym will be counted as orrect. Obsolete, foreign and shang names and expressions or given names of people are not permissible. Compound and hyphenated words will be accepted. Flowers and vegetables are considered as egrate objects, not as a group, and must be named according to the common names of the varieties shown, for example, instead of simply listing "Flowers" and "vegetables," varieties such as "Sun-flowers," "Bleeding hearts," "Cabbage," "Radishes," etc., hacorrect names count one point against the score of the contextant.

7. The winning list will be determined by all names of objects submitted by contestants and not controled by any predetermined list or "master" list.

8. Only one prize will be awarded in any one houshold, but all members of the household may assist in the solution.
