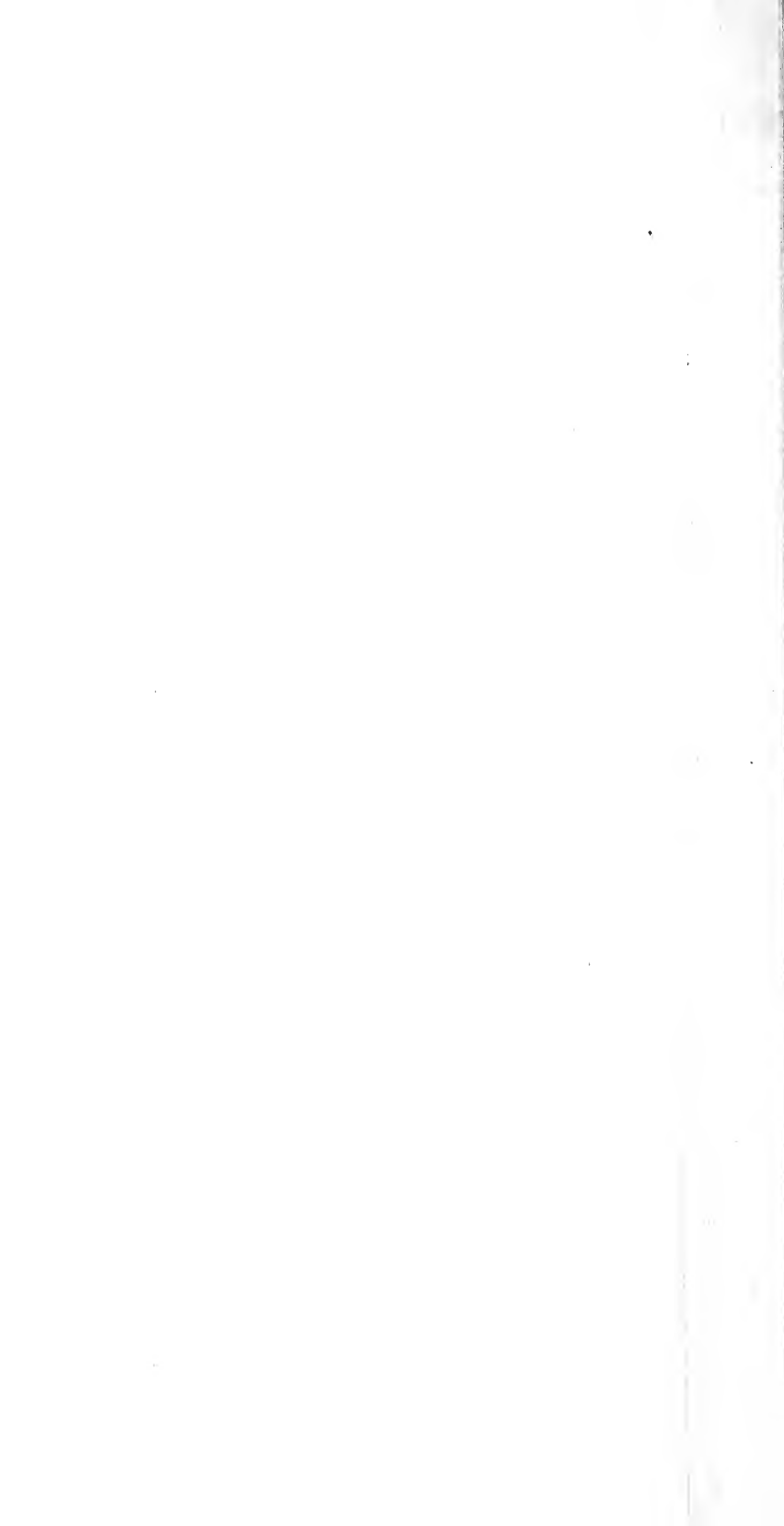

TERMS: Cash. Thirty days net or 2% discount for cash within ten days from date of invoice to domestic book customers. We expect remittance with order or other arrangements, satisfactory to us, from our foreign customers. Prices are quoted and remittances are expected in U. S. money.
