In other words we are pricing you for \$1.00, the same amount of trees, and as good ones as the tree dealer will sell you for \$2.00. All reliable agents or tree dealers charge you at this rate because they have to get about double to pay expenses, take care of the bad orders and make a profit for themselves; and great many crooked ones make you pay four or five times its worth for very poor stock.

If you want to buy your trees for the least money, why not send your order direct to us and pay only your own bill?

Our terms are cash with the order.

We pay the express on all orders of \$10 or more. On orders of less than \$10 we pack carefully and deliver to Freight, Express or Post Office. See Parcel Post table on back page to find how much to send for postage.

If you are not entirely satisfied with your stock when received return to us at our expense and get your money back.
