It will be mutually understood and agreed between the purchaser and ourselves that unless there exists some special contract agreement to contrary, that the terms and conditions named in this list govern all wholesale orders and business with us.

We accept all orders upon condition that they shall be void should any injury befall the stock from digging, frost, hail, storm, fire, insect pests, infections, quarantine regulations or other causes beyond our control. We assume no liability if unable to fill any order or portion of order for any of these causes or supply becoming exhausted on account of orders previously booked, or error in counts and estimates.

Shipping Season October, Continuing Until May

Terms: 30 Days Net From Date of Invoice

CREDITS will be extended only to those who have done satisfactory business in the past, or those having established financial ratings, or who can furnish satisfactory bank and financial references or security.

STRANGERS will be required to comply with the above, or send cash with order.

CASH ORDERS are those where full amount of bill or cost of goods is paid before shipment of goods. No charge will be made for packing where cash in full accompanies orders, or is received before shipment of goods.

OUR LIABILITY AND GUARANTEE. We exercise the greatest care to keep our trees true to name, and hold ourselves in readiness at all times to replace, on proper proof, all stock that may prove otherwise, or refund the amount paid; but it is mutually agreed between the purchaser and ourselves that we shall not at any time be liable for any amount greater than the original price paid for trees. If goods are not accepted upon these conditions, they must be returned and money will be refunded.
