

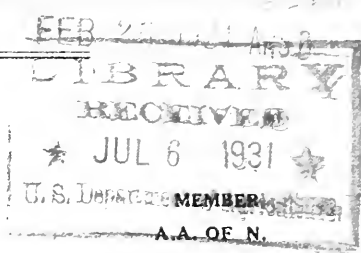

## APPLE PIECE ROOT GRAFTS

In making piece root grafts, we cut scions about 5 inches in length, and roots about  $3\frac{1}{2}$  to 4 inches in length, the scion and root are tongued together and properly wrapped with waxed thread. This grade of grafts, we use largely in our own plantings.

This grade of grafts are made by using 5 inch scions and the whole root from a No. 1 3/16ths grade straight root seedling, which makes a very strong graft. A Number of Nurserymen prefer this grade.

GRAFTS: Tied in bundles of 100, therefore do not order less than 100 of a variety.

ORDER EARLY: We begin grafting January 1st and continue until March 15th. Each order is grafted alone and packed away separately in our storage cellar until ordered shipped out by our customers.

OUR EXPERIENCE: The men in our grafting room have had fifteen to twenty years experience in this work and know how to put them up for best results.

PLANTING: Plant grafts early in the spring, in well prepared land. Press soil well about them when planting and set them about eight or ten inches apart in the row which rows should be  $3\frac{1}{2}$  to 4 ft. apart.
