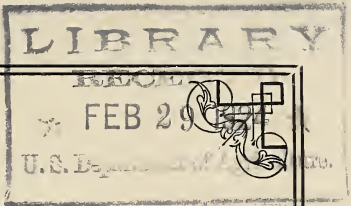

**ALL CLAIMS must be made upon receipt of goods.**

**TERMS CASH**, on or before delivery to express or railroad agents unless by special arrangement.

**Two hundred and fifty**, twenty-five or five of any one variety will be furnished at the thousand, hundred and ten rates, respectively, but single plants of one or more varieties will not be sold at less than 35 cents each, except Vines the minimum price of which will be 25 cents each.

**PACKING CHARGED EXTRA**, but only sufficient to cover cost of time and material consumed in the work. When sending cash with order, add fifteen per cent. to the amount of the bill to cover packing charges.

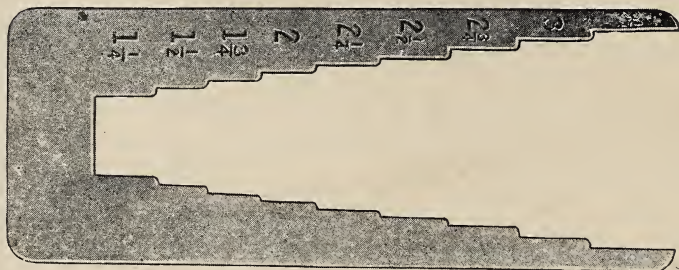
