At the Boston Show, August 11, 12, 1923, flowers from 1-2 to 3-4 inch bulbs were awarded the First Class Certificate of the Massachusetts Horticultural Society and also won in three competitive classes.

"Souvenir" is very early, perfectly healthy and vigorous and opens well when cut in bud, making it a fine commercial sort. The butterfly-like form of the blossoms is an added attraction.
