1.—Prices quoted in this list do not include express or mailage; if wanted by mail, figure parcel post zone rates per pound and add this to the price quoted. Dahlias weigh about 2½ pounds to the dozen.

2.—Orders from unknown parties must be accompanied by cash or satisfactory references. This rule is strictly enforced.

3.—No goods will be sent C. O. D. unless one-half the amount accompanies the order.

4.—No extra charge will be made for packing.

5.—Six articles of a kind at dozen rates; 25 at 100 rates.
