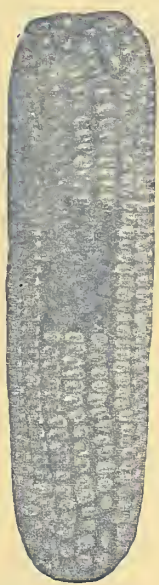

Figures on back of tags show result of our tests for germination. We have checked same against tests from the Agricultural College of your State. They are only for your information. Test your corn on receipt and if any difference appears between your test and ours, advise us promptly. Any seed corn that for any reason is not satisfactory to buyer can be returned at our expense and will be promptly adjusted by us.
