The Lewis Peonies are strong, vigorous stock, including new varieties that have been tested for a number of years, free bloomers showing a wide range of beautiful tints and colors, from pure white to the darkest shades of ox-blood red.

Peonies should be planted on well drained soil, free from shade at least half of the day; open sunlight being an advantage. They should be kept weil cultivated and no fertilizer placed in direct contact with the roots.

The eyes should be about two inches below the surface of the ground and mulching put on the first winter AFTER the ground freezes.

The prices quoted are for strong 3 to 5 eye divisions or plants of equal value, from healthy stock and true to name.
