

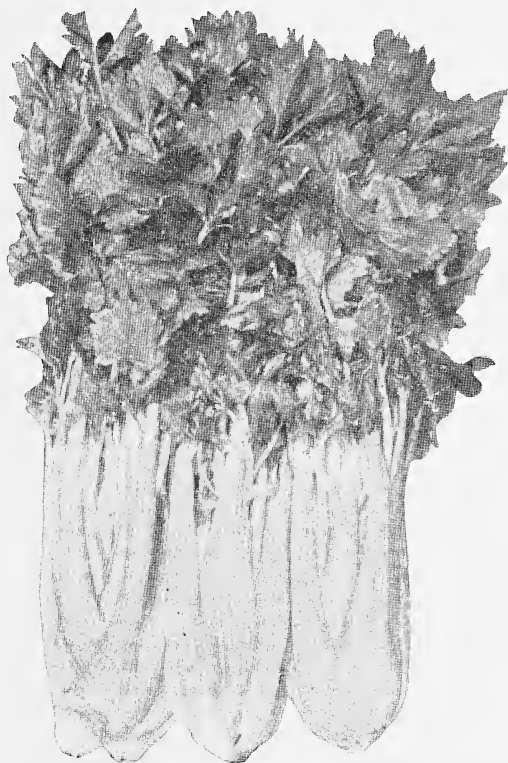

# Armour's Big Crop Fertilizers

## FERTILIZERS ARE PLANT FOOD CARRIERS

**Nitrogen**, referred to as Ammonia, is directly associated with the formation of leaves and stems in plants, promoting a quick and vigorous growth which is accompanied by a deep, rich green color of foliage—a sign of health and activity.

**Phosphorus**, known as Acid Phosphate or Phosphoric Acid, hastens germination and favors rapid development of young seedlings, increasing the root growth, thus giving the young plant a good start. The formation of grain and fruit begins sooner when applications of soluble phosphorus are freely made. Phosphorus fills out the grain and fruit, increasing the proportion of grain to straw.

**Potassium**, commonly called potash, has a marked influence upon the development of leaves and stems. When potash is lacking, stems are apt to be weak and brittle. Potash enables the plant to produce sugar and starch, and helps to plump and fill the grain. It is also necessary in developing the fleshy parts of fruit.

No complaint can be entertained unless made on receipt of the goods and invoice, and no warranty or guaranty is given either as to description, quality, productiveness or any other matter of any seeds I send you, nor will I be responsible for the quality or value of the crops produced therefrom. Nevertheless I will certainly pay attention to any founded complaint, but a restitution of any article can never exceed the amount charged for in the invoice.

Being able and ready to meet all respectable competition, I would be glad to be informed if you are offered any article lower than these prices, and in such cases, I will if possible, give you other quotations.

A new and adequate Parcels Post law now applies to shipments of seeds, bulbs, tools, plants and garden supplies to all of the United States; Packages are subject to a limit of maximum weight in the first and second zones of 50 lbs.; and in all other zones, third to eighth, of 20 lbs. The maximum size of a package is 72 inches for combined length and largest girth. Insurance will be effected only when asked for and remitted for as follows: Parcels to the value of \$25.00 or under for 5 cents; to the value of \$25.00 to \$50.00 for 10 cents. Postage must be remitted in addition to the price of seed.

## CARROT—"Market Favorite"

This variety deserves being strongly recommended, being very early, cylindrical stumprooted shape of fine scarlet color, and almost without core. It has but small top, but sufficient for bunching. For first early marketing the finest variety existent.

## CAULIFLOWER—"Gilt Edge"

A few days later than the Early Erfurt, but produces heads the size of the Danish Giant.

## CABBAGE—"The Bugner"

A winter variety bred yellow resistant by means of continual selection on yellowish soil near Chicago.

## CORN—"Early Surprise"

One of the earliest white cob Sweet Corns. Produces twelve-rowed pure white ears on four foot stalks.

## PEPPER—"Early Giant"

Early Giant is the earliest large green pepper, about 5 inches high by  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inches thick. The flesh is thick and of mild flavor, turning a bright red when ripe.

## PEPPER—"Yellow Antibes"

An early yellow pepper about 16 inches high bearing numerous sweet pendent fruits of a fine orange yellow when ripe. The shape is triangular with rounded angles about  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches long by 1 inch at top.
