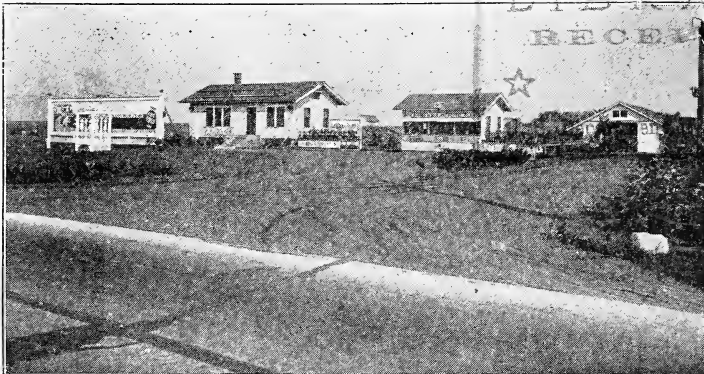

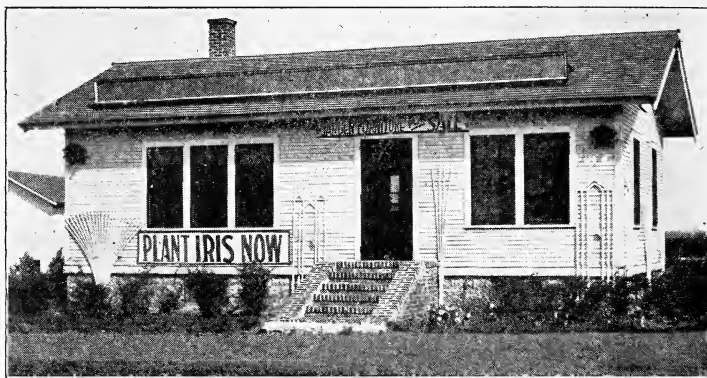

## GENERAL INFORMATION

**TERMS OF PAYMENT.** All our goods are sold 60 days less 2% cash in 10 days or we book the order and notify you within a few days of shipping time when a remittance can be sent and the goods will be shipped promptly. This last plan allows a 3% discount and free boxing. This will mean a saving of about 8 to 10% on orders for Shrubs, etc. All accounts shipped for Fall will be due December 1 and Spring shipments due June 1.

**CONDITIONS.** Customers will realize that it is not possible for us to control the movement of shipments whether by freight or express. We, therefore, assume no responsibility for the condition of shipments when delivered through the railroad or express company and should any damage be done in transit, claims should be filed with the carriers. The prices quoted herein do not include any guarantee as to the growth of the plants, shrubs, or bulbs.

**BOXING AND PACKING.** Boxes and bales will be charged for at cost except where cash accompanies the order when all packing will be done without any charge. We make no charge for delivery to the railroad station.

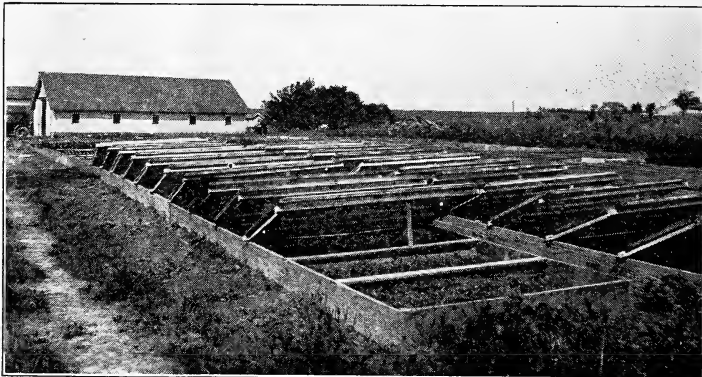

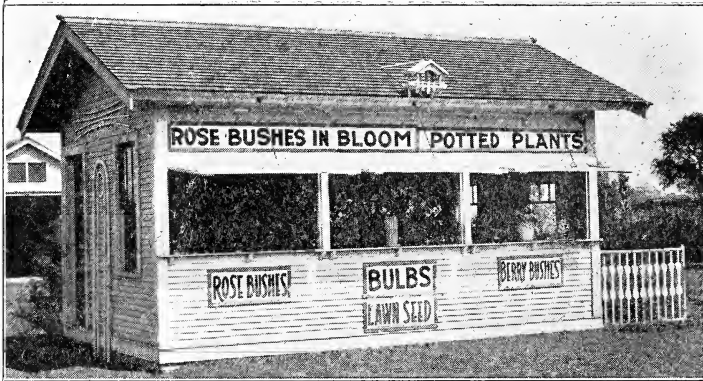
