ALL ORDERS are accepted subject to prior sale, and are shipped either postpaid or express prepaid. Orders of very large value are usually sent by express, for the express company insures safe delivery—even against freezing.

SUBSTITUTIONS: If I am out of the size of bulb ordered, I will give larger quantity of the same variety in the next smaller size I have in stock, unless you request me not to do so. I do not substitute one variety for another unless you so request.
