Make all checks, drafts and money orders payable to Buntings' Nurseries.

PACKING. We make no extra charge for boxing and packing, all stock is delivered f. o. b. train at prices quoted in this price list. We use damp moss in packing all stock, which insures safe delivery.

GUARANTEE. We guarantee all stock to be strictly firstclass and true to name and will upon proper proof refund the purchase price, or replace any stock which proves otherwise. It is understood and agreed that we will not be held responsible for any greater sum than the cost of the stock, should any prove untrue. We strive to avoid mistakes and believe we are as exact as any in the business.
