**Lilacs,**

Our Lilacs are grafted or budded very low on privet; they will quickly get on own roots after transplanting provided the union is placed about four inches below the surface of the ground.

The varieties marked \* belong to a new class of Lilacs, the "Early Lilacs," a cross between one of the early flowering Lilacs and Syringa Giraldi. This cross originated a new race of tall growing Lilacs, which flower before those now known.

We offer a "lining-out" grade; these are well branched plants 12-18 in. high. The other plants offered are 18-24 in. or larger according to variety.
