## Lilacs,

Our Lilacs are grafted or budded very low on privet; they will quickly get on own roots after transplanting provided the union is placed about four inches below the surface of the ground.

The varieties marked * belong to a new class of Lilacs, the "Early Lilacs," a cross between one of the early flowering Lilacs and Syringa Giraldi. This cross originated a new race of tall growing Lilacs, which flower before those now known.

We offer a "lining-out" grade; these are well branched plants $12-18 \mathrm{in}$. high. The other plants offered are $18-24 \mathrm{in}$. or larger according to variety.
