Coromaria. White and pink flowers, delightfully fragrant.
Floribunda-Purpurea. Flowers reddish in color.
Floribunda, Japanese Flowering Crab. One of the handsomest, bright pink flower buds, white flowers.
Halliana Parkmani. Bright rose-red, double flowers.
Ioensis Plena, Bechtel Crab. Double pink flowers, like small clustered roses.

Prunifolia Rinki. Large white flowers.
Sargenti. Very dwarf spreading Japanese variety. Pure white flowers with bright yellow anthers.
