THIS beautiful Iris is undoubtedly one of the world's best. In addition to its wonderful substance and delicate beauty, it is a most vigorous grower and prolific bloomer. The following description can not begin to do the flower justice—it must be seen to be appreciated.

DESCRIPTION

The standards and falls are pale bluish lavender with a faint creamy undertone. This creamy undertone often assumes the luster and iridescence which we see in the beautiful lining of many of the sea shells which produce "Mother of Pearl." The plant is tall, a vigorous grower and a profuse bloomer. One admirer writes, "My Mother of Pearl Irises are by far the handsomest I have ever seen. Four and five blooms on tall graceful stalks." Another writes, "My Mother of Pearl is now blooming—one gorgeous stalk, forty inches tall, with five beautiful blooms on it. The coloring is exquisite."

CLUNY

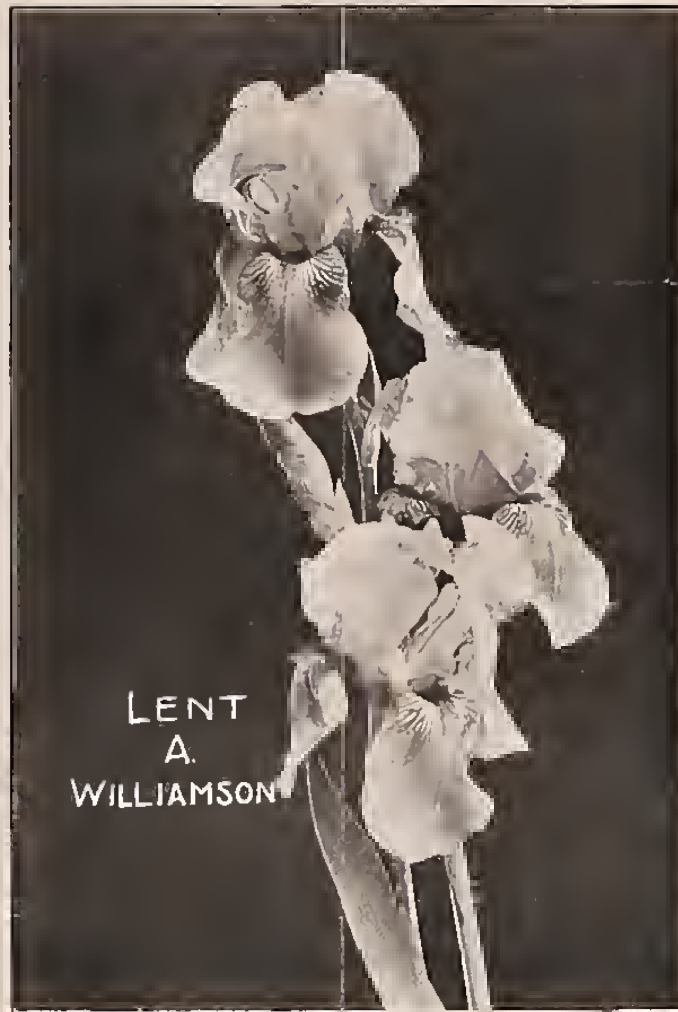
A tall Iris which produces light bluish-lavender blooms of good size. Has a splendid vigorous growing habit. .75 each
