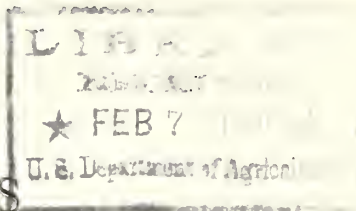

- AZALEA—calendulacea, dahurica, Ghent Hybrids, kaempferi, kaempferi hybrids, mucronulatum, rosea, poukanensis, vaseyi.
- Clematis texensis. Clethra fargesii. Cornus kousa.
- COTONEASTER—acutifolia, villosula, bullata, dielsiana, divaricata, francheti, francheti cinerascens, horizontalis perpusilla, moupinensis, nitens, racemiflora soongarica, tomentosa.
- Deutzia scabra, Enkianthus campanulatus. Hydrangea petiolaris.
- Kolkwitzia amabilis. Leucothoe valesbei.
- LONICERA—Korolkowi, macki, macki podocarpa, morrowi.
- Rhododendron hybrids in varieties. Sorbaria arborescens and sorbifolia.
