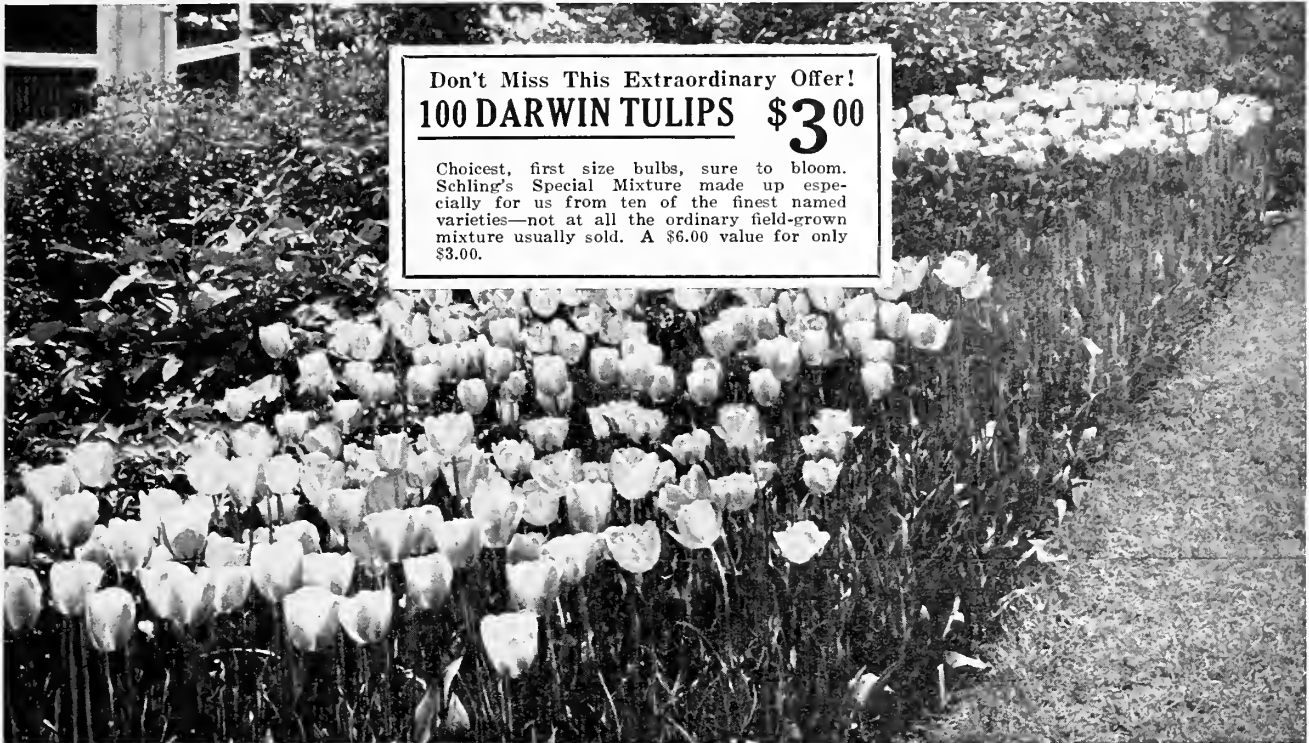

BOTANICAL TULIPS (SPECIES) FOR THE ROCK GARDEN

A most interesting group of Wild Tulip species native of the mountain slopes and valleys of Central Asia and Asia Minor—lovely odd shapes—many with reflexed petals and curiously twisted, spotted and reflexed foliage. They simply belong to the rock garden where their individual beauty stands out most prominently, here they thrive and increase if left in the ground year in and year out. Plant them in groups of 6 to 12 among the rock in fairly deep, well drained pockets.

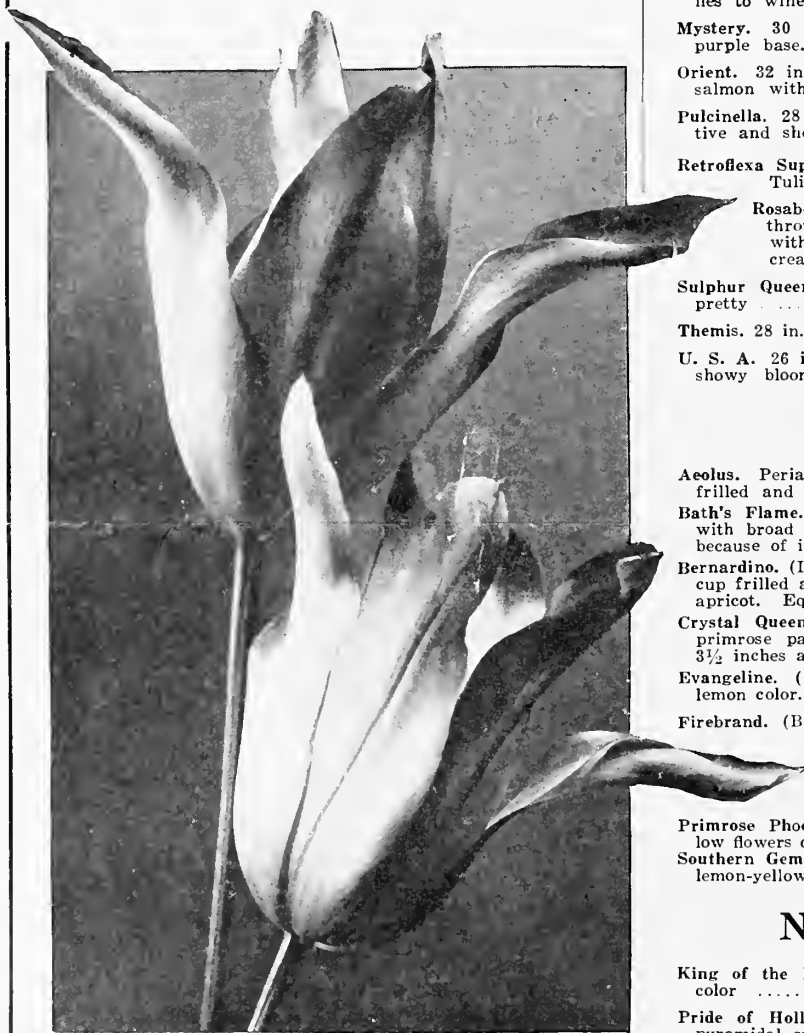

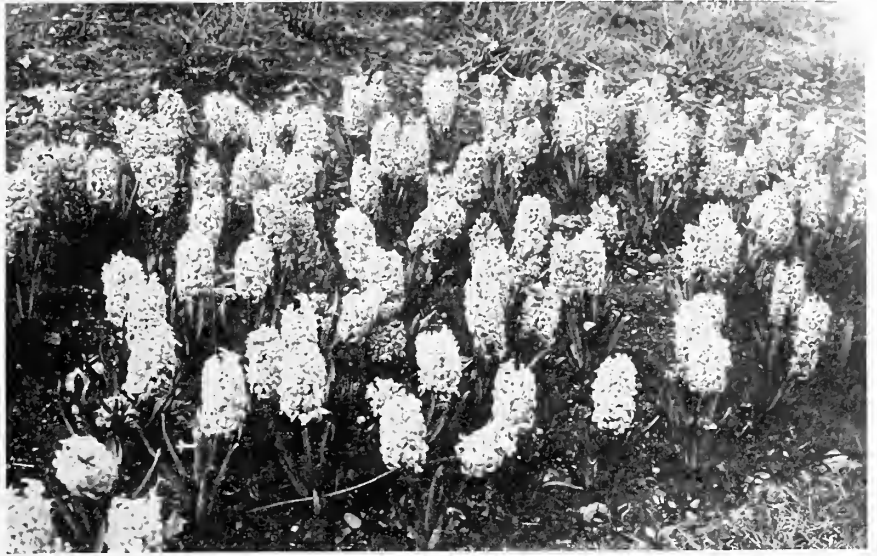

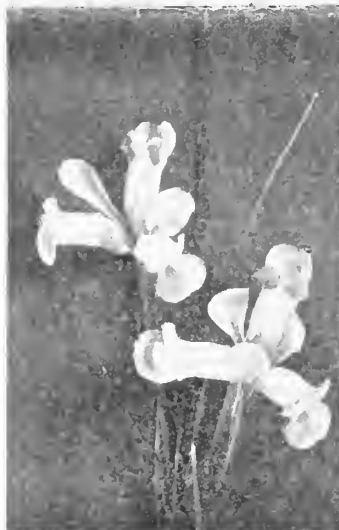
