Due to the fact that this list is out before digging time we have not listed first sized bulbs, but bulbs from No. 2 size down, as we cannot tell in the field just in what quantity the first-sized bulbs will grade out. However, practically all the sizes will give you good blooms, and the No. 2 and 3 sizes virtually as good as those of the first size, at a less cost.

The quality of our bulbs and varieties listed will stand up against those grown by anyone anywhere. Our repeat orders from old customers grow by a heavy percentage every year, the best possible indication of satisfaction.

If out of one size of variety we will substitute next nearest size in stock in proportion to amount ordered.

Just a few words about our Gladiolus. We grow all of our bulbs under Skinner irrigation system, with intensive cultivation and we never plant our Gladiolus twice in the same ground, or where bulbs have grown before. This is one of the best possible protections against fungus diseases in Gladiolus, but in addition all of our stock was given thorough Semesan treatment this year, and all will be sent out under the inspection of the Oregon State Board of Horticulture. Our bulbs are kept in a new, model concrete warehouse, with ample storage space under the most modern conditions of storage, also another very important item in the production of clean, healthy bulbs.

We invariably prefer to make spring delivery on our Gladiolus although we will attempt to make deliveries earlier if necessary in climates where planting requirements call for earlier shipments. However, we have ample storage space, and we prefer to clean our bulbs after they are thoroughly cured and in proper condition for handling and unless there is some imperative reason for earlier shipment customers will find it preferable to allow us to make spring shipments. All larger orders are shipped by express.

Canadian Customers: We wish to remind you to secure permit numbers to accompany your orders and kindly remember to forward us labels furnished you by your Bureau of Plant Inspection to avoid possible complications at the border or destination point.
