Prices quoted are prepaid on orders of \$2.00 and over. Under \$2.00 add 25c for postage.

Shipments will be made from July to October. Good, strong, healthy rhizomes with a fine root system will be sent properly labeled and packed, insuring their starting into vigorous growth when planted.

Discounts: On orders of \$10.00 to \$25.00 a discount of 10% will be allowed. Orders of \$25.00 to \$50.00, discount 15%. Orders over \$50.00, discount 20%.

Collections and varieties marked net are not subject to discounts. All varieties are true to name. Satisfactory adjustment will be made on any proving otherwise.

Ratings: On the basis of 100 for perfection, ratings voted by members of the American Iris Society precede names of varieties. The first number is the exhibition rating, second number the garden rating.
