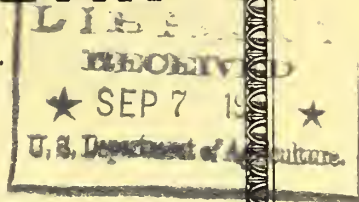

PRICES in this list cancel all previous prices and are subject to change without notice. For long and much assorted orders calling for only a few plants of each kind, it will be necessary to make an additional charge of 10 to 25 per cent.

TERMS—Regular terms to those of known responsibility; otherwise cash or security before shipment. Orders for C. O. D. shipment must be accompanied by one-third cash. We grant a discount of 2% when payment in full accompanies order. This does not apply to C. O. D. shipments. Packing is charged for at cost in all instances, excepting bulk carload shipments for which we make no packing charge.

SHIPPING—Please tell us how to ship your order, whether by freight or express, stating the route if you have a preference. In the absence of definite instructions, we will forward the way we think best, without assuming responsibility. All shipments travel at the expense and risk of the purchaser. We are served by the Santa Fe and Missouri Pacific railroads.

NON WARRANTY—If any nursery stock sold by us should prove untrue to name under which it is sold, we hereby agree on proper proof of such untruthfulness to name to replace such stock as originally ordered or to refund the purchase price. In no case shall we be liable for any amount larger than that originally received for said nursery stock. Except for such liability and in respect to all nursery stock sold by us, we give no warranty express or implied, as to description, quality, growth, productivity, or any other matter.
