The building which bears the sign "Bartling Seeds" is used by the Edward Bartling Seed Company, the picture shows the front or office entrance, the warehouse and cleaning rooms do not show in this picture. The next building is occupied by the Dunlop Tire and Rubber Company's retail store, selling new tires, tubes, batteries and oil. The small box building is the quarters for the Fourth Ward Company, dealing in ice, its business is selling direct to the consumer at 40c per hundred pounds. The filling station handles the Sinclair Gas and is known as the Sixteenth Street Filling Station. These concerns invite your patronage.

These machines have served in other purposes, such as cleaning beans, and have separated mixtures of grains. They are at your service. RED CLOVER SEED

During the past twenty years the acreage of Red Clover Seed has been reduced about 80 per cent, due principally to the high price of the seed and the popularity and low price of Sweet Clover Seed. This year Red Clover is lower in value than for fifteen years. This fact, and the adaptability of Red Clover to the farm in eastern Nebraska will bring a heavy demand for this seed next spring. At present values, using 8 to 12 pounds of seed per acre, it costs just a little more to seed red than sweet clover. The advantages are better hay, pastures, and the seed crop is remunerative.

We will save you money on Red Clover Seed. We are large handlers of Red Clover Seed. Our supply comes from the farmers in a section around and near Nebraska City, a territory that produces more Red Clover Seed than any part of Nebraska.
