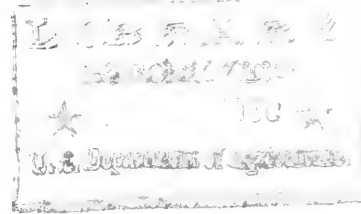

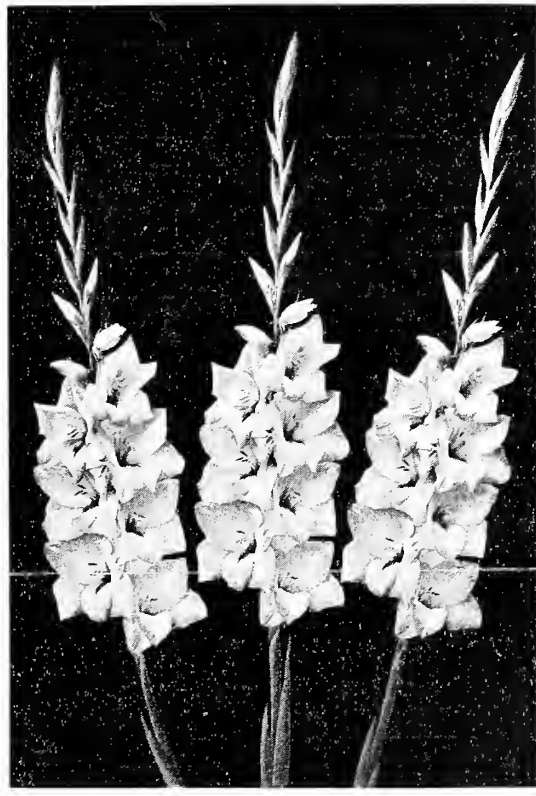

When purchasing bulbs it is well to remember that medium size bulbs are most economical. Bulbs of this size bloom nicely and supply large bulbs with an abundance of bulbets for the following seasons.

BULBLETS

Bulbets can and should be grown by the amateur. If you so request, we will supply directions for germinating bulbets with each shipment.

TERMS: Cash or 20% deposit, Balance before shipment or C. O. D. All bulbs offered subject to prior sale.

SUBSTITUTION—

We do not substitute without your permission.

If you give us permission to substitute the next smallest size, we will do so when necessary and give you 10% extra value in the size substituted.

TIME OF SHIPMENT—

Except upon special request we do not ship until the weather becomes entirely settled. Usually our shipping season starts about March 25. If you desire an early shipment we would appreciate the early receipt of your order.

QUANTITIES OTHER THAN LISTED—

When not listed, 10 bulbs or bulblets will be supplied for the price of 8 and 100 at 8 times the price of 10. If interested in special quotations we solicit your correspondence.

EXTRAS AND DISCOUNTS

All orders are filled with at least 10% in extra count.

Cash orders received prior to March 15 will be allowed 5% extras of your own selection in addition to the above.

In addition quantity discounts will be allowed as follows:

5% on orders from \$10 to \$25.

10% on orders over \$25.
