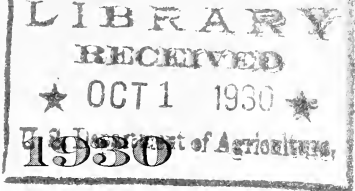

In addition to the plants listed in my catalogue, I have the following ready for autumn delivery:

**Aquilegia—Chrysantha.**—The Golden Columbine. In bloom for most of the summer.

**Linum Perenne.**—Blue Flax.

**Penstemon Barbatus Torreyi.** A charming and graceful plant, bearing tall, slender spikes of coral red flowers in July and August. Very desirable for the border.

### Phlox

**Miss Lingard.**—Early white.

**Mrs. Jenkins.**—The best late white.

**Platycodon Mariesi.**—Blue balloon flower.

**Sweet William.**—Grown from Sutton's seeds. Beautiful, pure colors.

**Sutton's Fairy.**—Delicate salmon pink. A lighter shade than Sutton's Pink Beauty.

**Sutton's Scarlet Beauty.**

**Aquilegia Haylodgensis Hybrids.**—Grown from seed from the Royal Moerheim Nurseries of Holland.

**Dianthus Speciosus.**—A delightful pink for the sunny side of the rock garden. Rosy lavender flowers, with petals deeply fringed, and a most delicious perfume.
