Bush Roses

- Angele Pernet.** H. T. New. Regarded the most striking colored rose in existence. Buds flaming orange, opening to rich browning orange75c
- Dame Edith Helen, HT, Pink.** It is almost unnecessary to say that this is the one most popular pink rose which everybody must have75c
- Etoile De Hollande.** Hybrid Tea. Maroon Red; full and fragrant\$1.00
- Frau Karl Druschki.** Absolutely pure white rose, with immense long buds and very double flowers50c
- Feu Joseph Looymans.** Color apricot—opens to golden buff. Buds long and beautiful form. Foliage bright and glistening.\$1.00
- General McArthur.** H. T. Crimson scarlet, free blooming, large double, and fragrant50c
- Golden Emblem, HT, Yellow with Red veining.** A fine rose in all sections of the country, but particularly so on the Pacific Coast where it is easily the outstanding yellow rose75c
- Hadley.** A brilliant rich crimson rose, which with its vigorous growth, long stems, mildew-proof foliage, full blooms and rich fragrance is close to the top in red roses50c
- Hoosier Beauty.** H. T. Big blooms of dark red, double, always admired50c
- K. A. Victoria.** Pure ivory white; producing quantities of beautiful buds and full flowers. Probably the best white rose for California because it blooms so freely and continuously50c
- K. of K.** (Kitchener of Khartoum.) An intensely brilliant scarlet rose with a velvety sheen. The flowers are semi-double with recurved petals, intensely fragrant 50c
- Lady Alice Stanley.** H. T. Outside petals coral-rose, inside pale flesh-pink. Free blooming plant. A good rose for cutting50c
- Lady Margaret Stewart.** Hybrid Tea. Sunflower yellow buds, splashed with scarlet; fragrant\$1.00
- Los Angeles.** H. T. Luminous flame pink, toned with coral. Has held the public favor to a greater degree than any other rose75c
- Louise Catherine Breslau.** H. T. A distinct shade in roses. Buds coral-red opening into cup-shaped flowers of salmon shading to various hues of pink, orange, and copper50c
- Margaret McGredy.** H. T. Large semi-double blooms of orange-scarlet changing as opens to carmine rose. Blooms on long stem. Plant strong grower. A worthy new variety\$1.00
- Miss Rowena Them.** H. T. Combines the good qualities of the Radiance and Los Angeles, of which it is a cross. Blooms long and pointed which appear in good quantities all the year; fragrant\$1.00

- Mrs. Lovell Swisher**, HT. Long, exquisitely formed buds of coppery-salmon, shading to flesh, bearing an endless succession of perfect flowers\$1.00
- Mrs. W. C. Egan**. Hybrid Tea. Flesh color with golden tints at petals' base; fragrant; lasting; long stems75c
- Padre**. Per. Coppery scarlet flushed with yellow at base of petals. Free flowering75c
- Patience**. (McGredy, 1927). The color is scarlet-carmine, varying at times to orange-scarlet and carmine. Long slender buds expand into a splendidly formed flower which holds its color well75c
- President Herbert Hoover**. A blend of pinks and orange-yellows; good color from bud to flower\$1.00
- Souv. de Claudius Pernet**. Per. New. Clear sunflower yellow unstained by any other color. Foliage holly-like...75c
- Souv. de Georges Pernet**. Per. New. Brilliant pink overlaid with orange yellow. Exceedingly attractive50c
- Radiance**. H. T. Heading the list of the American Rose Society for two years. Produces extra large blooms and many of them. Colors silvery pink shaded with deeper color50c
- Red Radiance**. H. T. Clear red, otherwise same as Radiance50c
- Rev. F. Page Roberts**. H. T. New. A sensation among new yellow roses. Buds stained copper, open out buff yellow on inner side of petals with deep salmon on outer side.\$1.00
- Rose Marie**. H. T. Rose pink with fringed petals. A fine fragrant garden rose75c
- Talisman**. This variety created a sensation at shows where it was exhibited last year, being awarded gold medals at several shows. In color it is a combination of gold, apricot, yellow and old rose. The bud is long, perfectly formed. Plant strong, vigorous grower with glossy green foliage\$1.00
- William F. Dreer**. H. T. Soft apricot-pink, exceedingly lovely with additional colors. Profuse bloomers50c

Climbing Roses

- Cl. Belle of Portugal**. Flowers of soft pink and salmon. Long buds, rapid grower. Blooms from January to June...75c
- Cl. Cecil Brunner**. T. Pink. Small button-hole flowers...50c
- Cl. General McArthur**. HT. A true sport from the popular bush variety possessing the same bright scarlet crimson shade. Climbs vigorously and satisfies the demand for a red ever-blooming climber50c
- Cl. Golden Emblem**, HT, Yellow. The Climbing Golden Emblem leads all yellow climbers on the Pacific Coast. It is an extremely strong grower with great long canes, bearing a profusion of the same wonderful golden blooms as the bush75c
- Cl. Hadley**. H. T. The deep crimson, fragrant blooms of this popular rose are here found upon a vigorous climbing sport, and are produced all through the summer75c
- Cl. Hossier Beauty**. HT. Like the bush form in all respects except for its vigorous climbing habit. Rich velvety scarlet75c
- Cl. K. A. Victoria**. HT. A grand white climbing rose; large deep and double; it is the strongest growing, freest blooming and most satisfactory of the white climbing roses...50c
