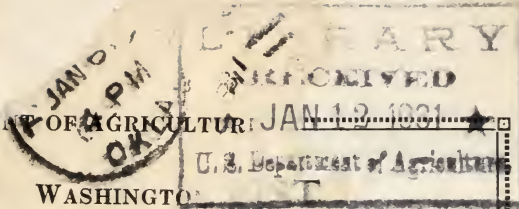

We have adopted the mail order plan of business and in this price list we are giving you the agent's or dealer's profits, which reduces the cost of your Nursery Stock about fifty percent.

In other words, we are pricing you for \$1.00 the same amount of trees and as good ones as the tree dealer will sell you for \$2.00. All reliable agents or tree dealers must charge you at this rate because they have to get about double to pay expenses, take care of bad orders, and make a profit for themselves, and a great many crooked ones make you pay four or five times its worth for very poor stock. We grow our own trees.

Our terms are cash with the order.

The prices in this list are net on less than \$10.00, f. o. b. here, for express or parcel post. When postage is allowed see table on back page to find amount to send for postage. \$10.00 to \$20.00, we pay express or postage; \$20.00 to \$100.00, we pay express or freight and allow 5% discount; \$100.00 or over, we pay express or freight and allow 10% discount.
