LOCATION: Our nurseries are located three and one-half miles north-west of the center of Dayton, on the corner of Siebenthaler Avenue and Catalpa Drive.

To reach the nurseries by trolley: Take north-bound Peoples Railway Car, out Main Street to Siebenthaler Avenue, then one-third mile west; or take north-bound Dayton Street Railway to loop [Catalpa Drive] and walk one mile due north.

To drive to the nurseries: Out North Main Street to Siebenthaler Avenue and one-third mile west, or north on Salem Avenue to Catalpa Drive and one mile north.

CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION will be furnished with each shipment.

This list cancels all previous quotations and the prices therein are subject to change without notice. All agreements and contracts are made subject to crop losses through unavoidable causes.

TERMS: Cash or security before shipment of goods, except with firms of established integrity, when, if unknown to us, satisfactory references will be required before goods are forwarded. All accounts are due and payable on the first of the month following the date of invoice, unless otherwise agreed upon. **At the prices named herein 5 plants will be furnished at the 10 rate; 6 at the 12 rate and 25 at the 100 rate.**

SPECIAL SELECTION: Stock specially selected at the nurseries either by the purchaser or, at his request, by us will be charged for in accordance with the value of the particular plants selected. The prices in this list cover the average good grade as they run in the nursery row.

WARRANTY: We guarantee our plants to be true to name, healthy and in good condition when they leave our nurseries and hold ourselves in readiness at all times to replace, free of charge, all plants that may prove otherwise, or refund the amount paid, but in no case shall we be liable for any amount greater than the original price. We do not guarantee our plants to live when sold at these prices and no allowance will be made for any that fail to live. All claims for errors, except as to trueness to name, must be made within five days after receipt of goods, or they will not be considered.

DELIVERY: We make no charge for delivery to the railroad station. Customers are requested to give definite shipping instructions, otherwise we will use our best judgment but with the express understanding that we assume no responsibility. When truck delivery is desired, we are usually in a position to accommodate the purchaser in this respect for limited distances, for which service we make a nominal charge. We advise that all herbaceous plants be shipped by express. All shipments travel at the risk and cost of the purchaser.

PACKING: All prices are for goods in the nursery, packing extra at cost, except in the case of evergreens, upon which the prices named include balling and burlapping. **When it is desired that plants, other than evergreens, be dug with the earth on the roots or balled and burlapped, an additional charge will be made as follows: For small plants, 10 cents each; 2 to 3 ft. sizes, 15 cents each; 3 to 4 feet sizes, 20 cents each; 4 to 6 feet sizes, 25 cents each; 6 to 8 feet sizes, 50 cents each.** Bales will be charged for at 25 cents each and up according to size. Boxes will be charged for as follows:
