HAIRY OR WINTER VETCH

A fall crop that gathers nitrogen from the air like clover. Makes an excellent hay, and is a splendid fertilizer and soil improver. It pays to inoculate vetch before sowing. Sow 1 bushel of rye and 20 pounds of vetch to the acre.

CRIMSON CLOVER

An annual clover that can be sowed at this time of the year which as a soil improver, a hay crop or grazing crop can't be beat, provided there is a reasonable amount of rain during the fall months. Crimson Clover will do everything for the land that Rye will do; in addition it is a legume and fertilizes the land by adding nitrogen. Tobacco after Crimson Clover has a color and quality that cannot be surpassed. It is sown in August and September, the sooner the better, at the rate of 1 bu. to 3 acres.
