

A NEW RACE OF RED APPLES

The pile of dark apples at the extreme left is fruit from the one "sport" limb of Blackjon, which was all Extra Fancy for color—97 per cent. The three piles to the right represent common Jonathans from other portions of the tree which graded (reading from left to right) 43 per cent "C" Grade, 34 per cent Fancy and 23 per cent Extra Fancy, for color.

BLACKJON has all the fine quality of common Jonathan—but the fact that it COLORS EARLY—and is colored a DEEP, SOLID RED, makes it a very profitable early apple to grow.

BLACKJON, because of its early coloring, can be harvested early—when the fruit is in prime condition to ship. Blackjon is to the Jonathan class of apples what the famous RICHARED has been to the Delicious.

Pollenization of Delicious and Winesaps is becoming one of the acute problems the grower has to face today. Jonathans have been found an excellent pollenizer for these two varieties. Uncertain, variable returns for the common Jonathan has caused a lack of clanting. Now it is possible to use Elickyon as a pollenizer for Delicious and Winesap, and be assured of fruit that can be picked for early shipment—without the old trouble of waiting for color, as with ordinary Jonathan.

Early matured, well colored Jonathans ARE profitable. Last season (1929), one orchardist in the Orondo district—on early district, sold his Jonathans combination pack for \$2.08 per box. His Delicious, Extra Fancy, Fancy, and C Grade, netted him \$1.92, and his Winesaps about \$1.50.

In "early" districts, where a fine commercial apple is wanted for the early shipments, nothing finer and better can be selected than BLACKJON.

It is worthy of note that this is the first apple in the world for which U. S. Patent application has been made. This patent application has been filed by the C. & O. Nursery Co. with the U. S. Patent Office.

Blaxtayman keeps much better in storage. It does not scald. It has a tougher skin than the common Stayman and has never been known to "crack" on the tree.

The Rome Beauty, as a rule, like the Stayman Winesap, does not have an attractive color. While Rome Beauty has always been recognized for its regular and heavy crops, a large percentage of the fruit has gone in the lower grades because of the impossibility of developing sufficient color. The SEEANDO Red Rome overcomes this objection with its high color and likewise high percentage of Extra Fancy grade.

Commercial growers have found the Rome Beauty ideal as a filler in apple orchards, since the Rome is a very compact grower and bears as early as any apple variety we know. SEEANDO RED ROME is ideal for this purpose, since it embodies all the features of the ordinary Rome Beauty in respect to habits of growth quality of fruit, etc.—besides a DEEP, ERILLIANT RED color that adds immensely to its growing, harvesting, and market value.

The BLACKMACK originated in the Canadian Okanogan country. It is earlier coloring, a solid DEEP RED, making it a better seller than the ordinary McIntosh.

Because it is earlier coloring and a deeper, solid red than common McIntosh its harvest and shipping season is more in control of the grower, and much better prices obtainable.

Like the Blaxtayman, the Blackmack can, by earlier picking, sliminate loss from windfalls, probably the most serious objection to the McIntosh.

For the grower located in the higher altitudes, where it is desirable to grow an apple of the McIntosh type, we can recommend "BLACKMACK" as being the best in its class.

As with other bud-sports, we have conducted extensive and thorough tests. Blackmack has now reproduced itself in successive generations proving that it grows true to type of the original parent tree from which we propagate.


Mr. Leo Antles, Production Manager of the American Fruit Growers, Inc., has given it his approval, and has planted the trees in his own large orchard along with several thousand RICHARED DELICIOUS.

SEEANDO Winesap (Pronuonced "C. & O.") is much darker, also richer, and more brilliant red than the common Winesap. It has no stripes.

SEEANDO Winesap colors earlier, and nearly all apples color Extra Fancy grade, only a few Fancy, and scarcely any "C" grade.

SEEANDO Winesap is a bud-sport, or mutation, of the common Winesap. It is like the Winesap in every respect, except that it is darker, earlier, color, and a greater percentage of the fruit grades EXTRA FANCY, which means more money for the grower.
