CASH WITH ORDER. Stamps accepted up to \$2.00; above that amount, check, money order or cash by registered mail. All checks and money orders should be drawn to the order of LOGAN DAHLIA GARDENS. Tubers will be sent near May 1. We pay the postage on retail orders, unless shipment is C.O.D., in which case the customer pays the C.O.D. charges.

HINTS ON GROWING GOOD DAHLIAS

If Dahlias are received before it is convenient to plant them, place in a shallow box of moist soil until ready to plant outdoors. Handle carefully. Broken necks will ruin the tubers. Be sure to lay the tubers flat, and plant about six inches deep and three or four feet apart. Do not fail to cultivate often. Fertilizer may be added when the dahlia is a few inches high and again when buds have formed. Water thoroughly about twice a week after buds have formed.

Dig the clumps of dahlias carefully a few days after the stalks are frosted. Turn the clumps upside down and dry for two or three hours if your cellar is very dry. If your cellar is too dry, line a barrel with newspaper, and store the clumps upside down in it. Always handle carefully. Cover the barrel with burlap, and examine the dahlias occasionally. Divide clumps in the spring.
