Small lots are sometimes cheaper by purcel post. Very heavy lots are cheaper by freight, but if weather is very hot, freight is not safe. In event no instructions are sent we use our best judgment but assume no risk. Large orders are sent shipping charges C.O.D. Parcel post packages are sent C.O.D.

We advise delaying shipping charges could. I after post provide an even both the growing or blooming stage, where tops must be crated, a small additional charge must be added. This means that mixed orders are usually sent in several installments as they mature. If this is not satisfactory we can usually store earlier ripened stock until others are ready, if requested. Sudden and severe hot spells, drouths, freezes or floods make some plants entirely disappear, therefore failures are not always the collectors fault.
