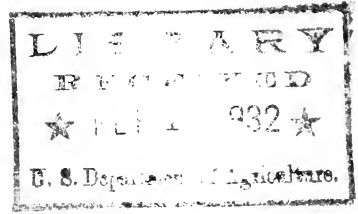

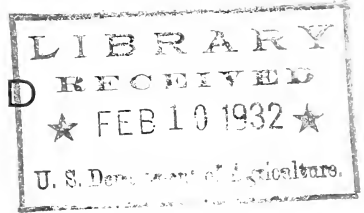

# FOREWORD

**H**EREWITH is submitted a list of Orchids representing one of the largest and most comprehensive selections of fine plants ever offered by any one establishment in America.

Every plant listed in this booklet is a special type of its particular variety; while those specially designated as *Good*, *Fine*, etc., are amongst the finest hybrids ever produced. Each plant has sufficient merit to make it worthy of consideration for hybridization purposes, and is sufficiently strong to carry a seed pod. A number of them have already been proven as good parent plants having been used to produce some of the finest hybrids known to the Orchid world.

Since the Federal Horticultural Board has reduced the time limit for the release of imported Orchids from five years to two years, many of the new and fine varieties imported from 1927 to 1929 can now be offered for the first time. Some of our plants purchased as unflowered seedlings have produced flowers superior to any of those retained by the originators; and the prices, although rather high, are considerably less than those quoted by many English Orchid growers. This is especially the case with a number of the yellow and bronze flowering types such as B. L. C. Aprica, Heliolata, Irma, Mithra and Zena; Catt. Diana, Heliodor, and Veiris; L. C. Adrienne, Attraction, Jacquinetta, Mrs. Medo, Thurgoodiana and Zeno.

Cymbidium Erica, of which we have probably the largest stock in America, has produced many of the finest clear yellow and greenish yellow flowers of any Cymbidium hybrid yet produced. At the Philadelphia Flower Show in March, 1931, we exhibited ten plants of Cym. Erica all of different types. This group was given special recognition of merit through the award of a Silver Medal. Any selection of ten small plants of Cym. Erica, which we offer for \$100, can be reasonably expected to develop at least one type that alone will be worth the purchase price of the ten.

We fully guarantee every plant to be true to the variety as named or described, and offer them subject to their being unsold upon receipt of order. If orders are received for plants previously sold, we shall be pleased to recommend similar varieties where possible.
