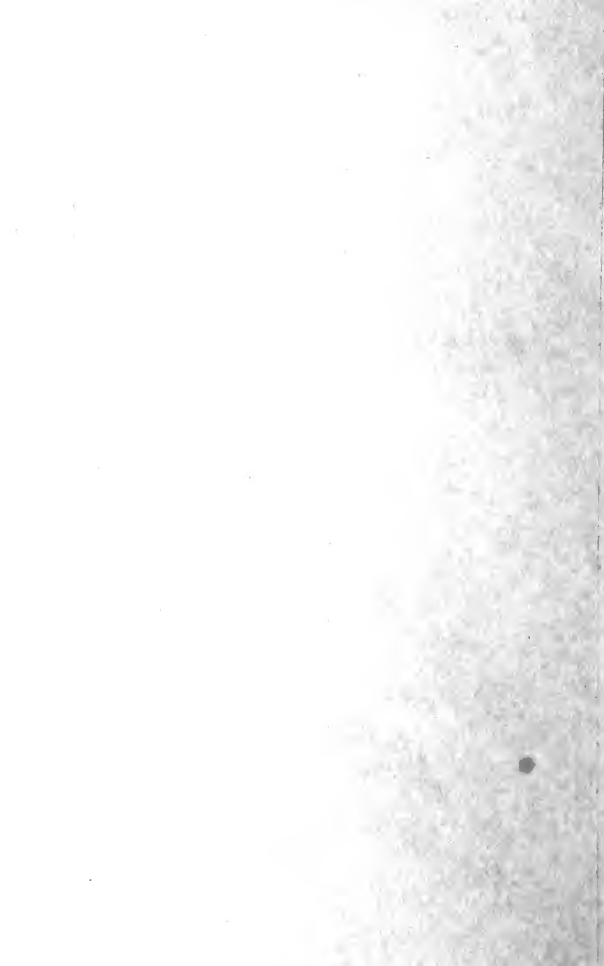

 Three and Four Years Old.

We grow both by budding and grafting according to variety; some doing better by grafting while others do better budded. In all cases we use the whole root insuring a good, vigorous root system which is the foundation of the tree. For those who wish a cheap tree we recommend our No. 1, 4 to 5 foot tree, which is just as good in quality but not as large, as it is one year younger.

These distances will vary some in different localities but for general use you will find these a fair average. Ascertaining the number of plants to an acre you will find the following rule convenient. To ascertain the number of plants required to the acre at any given distance, divide the number of square feet (43,560) in an acre by the number of square feet you desire to devote to each plant. For instance in currant bushes planted 3 by 4 feet, each plant will occupy 12 square feet, making 3830 plants to the acre.
