## Nurseries in Orange and Ventura Counties

### Vacuum Fumigation

We recommend that all citrus trees be vacuum fumigated before planting in the orchard, regardless of where they are grown or by whom. A great many nurseries that are reported clean are later found to be infested with some pest which should not be spread.

Vacuum fumigation, when done under proper conditions and in the correct manner, is not injurious to the plant and is the surest known way to eradicate scale and other pests which might be on the trees.

We have furnished many thousands of citrus trees to growers in every county in Southern California, many of which were vacuum fumigated, and the experienced planter always wants his trees vacuum fumigated, for in this way only can he be assured of absolutely clean trees, regardless of where they are grown or planted.

We hold trees several days after they are dug before fumigating them and several days after they are fumigated before delivery is made to the purchaser, thus if a tree should be injured because of a broken ball or any other reason, it is apparent before the tree is delivered.
