Succulent plants will be found useful as pot plants, in porch boxes and hanging baskets, as bedding and border plants, in the summer rock garden as well as in dish gardens, and in general landscape work in California and in the South. If not familiar with these plants let us make up an assortment suitable to your needs.

While succulent plants will survive under almost any conditions of soil and moisture, we find that most of them do well under the same conditions of temperature and moisture as used for the geranium. For potting we use a soil mixture composed of one-fifth sand, one-fifth leaf mold or German peat, three-fifths good garden loam, with the addition of some lime.
